Accidents happen. Take these steps to prevent accidental poisoning, or overdose.

- ✓ Use medications as prescribed
- ✓ Avoid mixing medications with alcohol & other drugs



Be Prepared Get a Naloxone Rescue Kit

Naloxone is a medication that reverses the effects of opioid overdoses. To get one:

- ✓ Visit your local pharmacy
- ✓ Call treatment providers in your area
- ✓ Talk to your doctor

-  **DON'T** flush or throw medications directly in the trash
-  **DO** use a drug deactivation pouch or damage medications by mixing them with coffee grinds or cat litter
-  **DO** use drug drop boxes at all SI NYPD precincts (available 24/7) or at participating pharmacies
